
Larry Ford Fieldwork Scholarship in Cultural Geography

In 2004 an anonymous donor gave the Association of Pacific Coast Geographers fifteen thousand dollars to establish the Cultural Geography Fieldwork Scholarship Fund and specified that the committee to review applications and make awards be comprised of Larry Ford, Susan Hardwick, and Paul Starrs. To date the committee has awarded seven scholarships of \$500 each.

Shortly after Larry died, the donor contacted Jan Ford to ask if the scholarship could be renamed in honor of Larry. Jan agreed with enthusiasm, and has urged people wanting to make a donation in Larry's memory to contribute to this scholarship. Larry was known for his foot-powered fieldwork in cities all over the world (a process he liked to call "lurking") so it is particularly appropriate to have a scholarship in Larry's name that emphasizes fieldwork.
